### Objectives for Participants:

- **Comprehensive understanding** of the challenges, policies, and mechanisms that shape the San Ramon Valley, allowing participants to fully grasp the complexities of our community
- **Leadership development** that empowers participants to drive positive change
- **Meaningful connections** among class members, community leaders and policy makers that promote collaboration and synergistic efforts.
- **Creative Problem-Solving** by engaging in robust dialogue to effectively address current and future community issues



### Overview of the Program:

- Founded in 1992
- Up to 30 participants per class
- Monthly full-day class sessions, each focused on a different topic or theme (August to May), held at a different location in the valley
- Board members chair each day, arranging for policymakers, community leaders and subject experts to share insight and expertise
- A class project
- Discounted tuition (\$1200) for participants from non-profits, small businesses and individuals paying for themselves. Additional assistance is available.

**At each class session**, engaging speakers, panelists, and community leaders and officials share their unique experiences and expertise. Class members interact with subject-area experts in fieldwork assignments and during the class sessions.
